August 1<sup>st</sup> 1902, the Board of County Commissioners of Deuel County S.D. met at the office of the county auditor, Leelan Lake ~~to~~ as per adjournment.

Members present: O. S. Johnson Chm. Julius Palmer, E. E. Dislad, Anton Artus, W. D. Clark.

Mathias Herriges of Gary S.D. presented his liquor bond which was upon motion approved:

On the ~~first~~ day of August, 1902, at two o'clock P.M. the matter of the application for incorporation of the proposed town of Brandt having been presented to this Board; and it appearing to this Board that due notice of hearing said application has been given by publication in the official newspapers of this county of Deuel; and this being the time fixed in such notice for hearing said application; and it appearing to the satisfaction of this Board, from the affidavit of E. J. Rose, that the survey, map and census of said proposed town were subject to examination in the manner and for the period required by law, and that all the requirements of the laws of this State concerning the incorporation of Towns have been fully complied with; it is therefore hereby

Ordered, That the following described territory, to-wit; All of Section Nineteen, the West half of Section Twenty, the North West Quarter of Section Twenty Nine, and the North half of Section Thirty, all in Township One Hundred Fourteen, Range Forty Eight, in Deuel County, State of South Dakota, shall with the assent of the qualified voters thereof be an incorporated Town by the name of "Brandt"; and it is further ordered that a meeting of the qualified voters resident in said proposed Town be held at the Hall over State Bank of Brandt in said proposed Town, on Tuesday, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1902, to determine whether such territory shall be an incorporated Town; at which meeting the polls shall be open at Nine O'clock in the forenoon and shall be kept open until four o'clock in the afternoon when they shall be closed.
