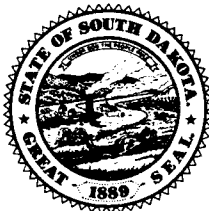

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE NONPROFIT RELIGIOUS CORPORATION KNOWN AS

MEADOW VIEW HUTTERIAN BRETHERN, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, Jake Wipf, John Wipf, and Sammy Waldner, of Alexandria and Bridgewater, South Dakota 57319, and all being over the age of twenty-one (21) years and residents of the State of South Dakota, for themselves and successors in interest and for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 47-22 of the South Dakota Compiled Laws and acts amendatory thereto enacting a nonprofit corporation which shall be nonprofit as designated by such act, and do hereby certify and declare as follows:

I

NAME

The name of this religious Corporation shall be "Meadow View Hutterian Brethren, Inc."

II

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business of the Corporation shall be 26081 439th Avenue, Bridgewater, South Dakota, 57319, and the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 415 South Main Street, 400 Capitol Building, PO Box 490, Aberdeen, South Dakota, 57402-0490.

III

INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered agent of the Corporation will be Jeffrey T. Sveen, whose address is the same as the initial registered office of the Corporation.

IV

CORPORATE PURPOSE

The purpose of the Corporation is to promote the Hutterian religious faith and church. It is a central part of the beliefs of the Hutterian Church that members should live together in a farming community, without individual ownership of personal or real property, and that they should devote their labors in harmony with the dictates of God's teachings; and further, that this Corporation shall provide the facilities and means to the members of said Hutterian Church to practice and observe their faith. To effectuate that purpose, the Corporation shall maintain living quarters and engage in a farming and agricultural operation, including livestock raising, dairy operations, and all agricultural enterprises connected therewith, and, to carry out its purposes, it may rent, buy, sell, mortgage, and hold real estate and contract for and exchange all classes and kinds of property incidental to its agricultural business. It may also take by devise, gift or bequest either real or personal property or any other thing of value to be used incidental to its agricultural business and/or church activities. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this Corporation is intended to be and shall be a religious or apostolic corporation, pursuant to Section 501(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and acts amendatory thereto and shall have a common treasury or community treasury; and the business which the Corporation shall engage in shall be for the common benefit of the members of the Corporation in carrying out and effectuating their Hutterian religious faith. The Corporation is further formed for the purpose of doing and engaging in any and all lawful activities that may be incidental to or reasonably necessary and related to any of the foregoing purposes and to have and exercise all of the powers and authorities now or hereinafter conferred upon religious, charitable or non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of South Dakota.

V

CORPORATE POWER

This Corporation shall not have or exercise any power or authority, either expressly or by interpretation or by operation of law, contrary to these Articles, nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity that would prevent this Corporation from qualifying or continuing to qualify as a corporation described in Section 501(d) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and acts amendatory thereto, contributions to which are deductible for federal income tax purposes.

VI

ACTIVITIES

That no substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall it, in any manner or to any extent, participate in or intervene in, including the publishing or distributing of statements, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; nor shall it engage in any activities that are unlawful under the laws of the United States of America, of the State of South Dakota, or any other jurisdiction where such activities are carried on.

VII

LIMITATIONS

This Corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade for profit, but shall be operated to provide facilities to effectuate the tenets of the Hutterian Church. Neither the whole nor any part or portion of the assets or net earnings of this Corporation shall be used, nor shall this Corporation ever be organized or operated for the purposes that do not comply with Section 501(d) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and acts amendatory thereto.

VIII

ASSETS

No compensation or payment shall ever be paid or made to any member, officer, director, trustee, creator or organizer of this Corporation or substantial contributor to it, except as a reasonable allowance for actual expenditures for the Corporation or work therefore, and neither the whole nor any part or portion of the assets or net earnings of the Corporation, current or accumulated, shall ever be distributed to or divided among such persons except as is provided in Section 501(d) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

IX

TERMINATION

In the event of termination, dissolution, or winding up of this Corporation in any manner or for whatever reasons, its remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to one or more of the Colonies of the Hutterian Church, which Colony or group of Colonies shall qualify under Section 501(d) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

X

POWERS

The powers and purposes of this Corporation shall at all times be so construed and limited so as to enable this Corporation to qualify as a religious Corporation under SDCL Ch. 47-22.

XI

CHURCH

This Corporation is a church and a religious Corporation and its members shall be associated with the Hutterian Church and Brotherhood, and all of its members shall live a communal life. No member of the Corporation shall live outside the Colony nor hold any real or

personal property rights individually, nor hold any property rights in the Corporation's property. Membership is voluntary. All rights of membership, grounds for their expulsion and managerial rules over the members of the Corporation and over the property of the Corporation shall be prescribed by the Bylaws, none of which shall be contrary to the tenets, rules or faith of the Hutterian Church.

XII

NON-PROFIT

This Corporation is a non-profit corporation, having no capital stock, and its term of existence shall be perpetual.

XIII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND INCORPORATORS

This Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than three (3) nor more than seven (7) members of the Corporation who will hold office for three years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. The names and addresses of the initial directors and incorporators of the Corporation to serve until the election of the first directors of the Corporation are as follows, to wit:

XIV

MEMBERSHIP

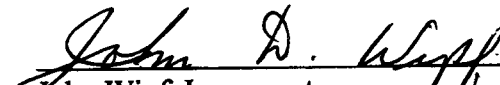
All persons who are dependent upon the community fund and treasury for their support shall be members of this Corporation. It is the intention of these Articles that this provision be literally construed to include as members all persons who fit the above description, regardless of age, occupation, capacity or disability. Persons who qualify for membership as set forth above shall only be removed as members by formal action of the Board of Directors as provided in the Bylaws. There shall be two classes of members. Voting members shall be all male, married members, and all others shall be non-voting members; provided, however, that the voting members may, by majority vote, admit others to voting membership as provided in the Bylaws.

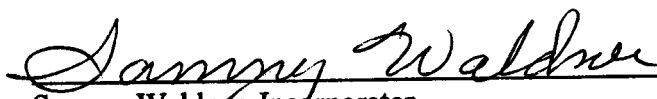
